It is to inform that, all the District Collector& Magistrates and Commissioners of Police Hyderabad and Cyberabad have been requesting for the Fire NOCs from the District Fire Officers concerned for issuance of Licenses/NOCs to dangerous and Offensive trades, K-Licenses for Explosives, Petrol pumps, Gas Godowns and places of Public Congregation under the provisions of A.P.Fire Service Manual/Other Acts and Laws. In this regard it is informed that Fire Service Act, 1999 was enacted by the Combined State of Andhra Pradesh and came into force from 01.02.2001 and Government vide reference 2nd cited amended the Fire Act and renamed it as "Telangana Fire Service Act, 1999."

2. In this regard it is to inform that as per Telangana Fire Service Act,1999 Section 13 "Any person proposing to construct a building of more than 15 meters height for commercial/business purpose, 18 meters and above height for residential purpose, and buildings of public congregation like schools, cinema halls, function halls, religious places, which are more than 500 sq. meters in plot area or 6 meters and above in height shall apply to the Director General or any member of the service duly authorized by him in this behalf, before submission of such building plans to the authority or officer competent to approve the same under the relevant law, for the time being in force, for a no objection certificate along with such fee as may be prescribed".

3. In view of the above, all the District Collector & Magistrates and Commissioner of Police Hyderabad and Cyberabad are requested not to forward the applications for issuance of any provisional/occupancy NOCs of Gas Godowns, Petrol Bunks and Explosives (Blasting permission) etc. which are not covered Under Section 13 of Fire Service Act, 1999. They may kindly forward applications for NOC for the premises covered under Section 13 of Fire Service Act only as detailed at para 2.
