PRESS NOTE

It may be recalled that on 06-11-2007 a serious fire accident occurred at M/s. Aurobindo Pharma Limited, Unit V, IDA Pasha Mylaram Village, Patancheru Mandal, Medak District in which Sri A. Kondaramulu was burnt to death and (i) Sri Y. Gangaraju, (ii) Sri Deepak seriously injured as they were trapped inside the building.

The loss was due to lack of Fire Safety systems. Consequently, the victims could not escape when the fire broke out. The Owner also failed to provide the mandatory Fire Safety measures viz., Automatic detection and alarm system, Yard Hydrant, Foam Monitors, Foam Compound (Reserve of 3,000 litres), Manually operated Fire Alarm system, 3rd party Fire Safety audit, Onsite emergency plan, appropriate training in usage of Fire Fighting equipment to all the staff members, Water Storage Over Head Tank and Static Tank, Fire Proximity suits, Breathing Apparatus Sets which could have prevented the loss of life and injuries to the victims.

In a landmark judgment on 10th April, 2008, the Additional Judicial First Class Magistrate, Sangareddy convicted the two accused persons namely (1) Sri P. Satyanarayana, Dy. General Manager (Operations) and (ii) Sri V. Shanker Subbu, Plant Manager when they admitted the Offence and pleaded guilty voluntarily u/s 21 of A. P. Fire Services Act, 1999 read with Rule 26(2), 31 and 32 of A. P. Fire & Emergency Operations and Levy of Fee Rules, 2006. They were sentenced to pay a fine of Rs. 15,000-00 (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only) each or in default simple imprisonment for two months each.

You are requested to publish this information in the public interest, in order to deter other builders, from violating the provisions of A. P. Fire Service Act, 1999 which was enacted to safeguard the lives and property of citizens. Citizens may visit the website www.fireservices.ap.gov.in of A. P. Fire & Emergency Services Department in order to ascertain the mandatory requirements for Fire Safety.
